ENTRY FEES

PLEASE COMPLETE ONE ENTRY FORM PER DOG PER CLASS

(i.e. one entry form for Open B and another entry form for Utility B)

Entry fee for each dog for each trial \$25.00

Entry fee for same dog entered in Open B and Utility B for each trial \$45.00

Entry fee for same dog entered in all four trials \$90.00/class

Overpayment of entry fees will be considered a donation to the club.

All entries must contain complete information as required by the CKC rules. All entries must be accompanied by the entry fee, in full, and all listing fees where applicable. A listing fee as established by the CKC must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration number is not shown on the entry form or ERN notice.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made. Overpayments will not be refunded.
- ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED IN OBEDIENCE COMES INTO SEASON after entry of the bitch has been submitted if a Veterinarian's certificate, (certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten-day period preceding the trial), is delivered to the Trial Secretary on or before the date of the trial. As this is a limited entry trial a small waiting list will be maintained to fill any vacancies due to withdrawals allowed by CKC regulations or due to a bitch in season.
- Entries must be typewritten or clearly printed. Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms. BSDCC does not assume any responsibility for incorrect information or errors due to illegibility of information on any entry form.
- ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED AFTER CLOSING DATE. Receipts and judging schedule will be emailed. Please ensure email address is printed on your entry form. Armband numbers and catalogues will be available one hour before the trials begin.
- (Chapter 3, Section 3.6.1 CKC Obedience Trial Rules & Regulations). "A judge officiating at a trial held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
- ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES. If not in competition, the dog must wear a collar and be on a leash a maximum length of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area.
- Dogs must be exercised in designated areas ONLY.
- An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry. This Notice of Withdrawal must be in writing and received by the Show Secretary on or before the official closing date and time as published in the Premium List.
- All Miscellaneous Class Dogs who do not have a Certification Number can only compete at the Novice level in Obedience Trials and must pay a listing fee of \$10.50. Those dogs with a certification number may proceed through all levels. Titles will only be awarded to those dogs that have been certified.
- In Transit permits will be available from the trial secretary if needed. Dogs not entered in the trials in the regular classes or exhibition only will not be permitted in the building without an In-Transit Permit.
- Performance Event Number (PEN) allows an unregistrable dog of a CKC recognized breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. For more information regarding applying for a PEN visit www.ckc.ca.
- Belgian Shepherd Dog Club Of Canada, its members and volunteers will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, BUT will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- The Trial Superintendent has the authority to expel any dogs deemed to be a danger to other dogs or people. There will be no refund for dogs that are expelled.

OFFICIAL CLASSES

Pre-Novice - The Pre-Novice class is an elective class for exhibitors and earning the title is not a requirement for a dog to enter Novice classes. The Pre-Novice class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has not earned the title of PCD. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all five exercises unless he has two or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercise. Only dogs that have not earned the title of CD may enter the Pre-Novice class.

Novice A - This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D. (Companion Dog). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. No person who has previously trained or exhibited a dog through its C.D.X. (Companion Dog Excellent) title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.

Novice B - This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D. (Companion Dog). Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B class at any one trial.

Novice C - The Novice C class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title CD or any higher obedience titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all six exercises unless he has two or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice C class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice C class are not eligible for High in Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title. Dogs may be entered in the Novice C class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.

Novice Intermediate - The Novice Intermediate class is an elective class for exhibitors and earning the title is not a requirement for a dog to enter the Open classes. The Novice Intermediate class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned a CD or any higher obedience trial titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all six exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice Intermediate class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High in Trial. Dogs may be entered in the Novice Intermediate class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.

Open HA / 18A - This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. (Companion Dog Excellent). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. Any person who has previously trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class.

Open HB / 18B - This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D. in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. No dog may be entered in both Open HA/18A and Open HB/18B at any one trial. A dog that has earned the title of C.D.X. must compete in Open B. Dogs eligible for entry in the Utility Class are also eligible for entry in this class.

Utility A - This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed that has earned the title of C.D.X., but has not earned the title of U.D. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.C.H title may not handle dogs in this class. Handlers may enter more than one dog in this class.

Utility B - This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed that has earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Utility A and Utility B at the same trial.

COVID-19 Protocol

General Required Practices

1. BSDCC members, judges and exhibitors are required to follow Federal, Provincial, local and facility guidelines as presented below. Any changes in guidelines between the posting of this Premium List and the starting of each trial will also be followed.
2. Social distancing must be practiced. Maintain a distance of 6 feet / 2 Metres or more unless individuals are part of a family unit.
3. Masks are required unless running a dog in a class. Masks are to be supplied by exhibitors for their personal use.
4. Exhibitors may consider wearing disposable or washable gloves unless running a dog in a class.
5. There will be plenty of hand sanitizer around the facility for personal use.
6. Wash hands as frequently as possible.
7. No handshakes or hugging.
8. Do not touch dogs that are not your own.
9. Bring your own pen/pencil. No common use pencils, pens or markers will be available
10. **Absolutely NO PARKING in front of the Boarding kennel building!!!!!!!!!!!!**
Parking available along the North side of the driveway (along the on site residence yard)

Information applicable to all participants

1. The trial has been limited to 50 humans at the venue at any one time. The limit applies to entrants, judges, Club members and all persons present (including spouse, significant other, family members). **No spectators other than competitors.** While seated in the bleachers, exhibitors must maintain social distancing from non-cohort exhibitors. No dogs in bleachers.
2. Score sheets will not be handed out, exhibitors will be given the opportunity to take a photo of their sheet
3. Ribbons and rosettes will not be available. There will be a self-serve prize table. Exhibitors may pick up their prizes once rounds are completed. Please only touch what you are taking and be sure to maintain social distancing.

Trial Practices

1. Each exhibitor will provide a completed waiver of liability for BSDCC and Parkland Kennels. Waivers will be given to the trial secretary as part of your entry package before the first morning of the trials. No one will be allowed to participate who has not completed the required waiver.
2. Anyone exhibiting COVID symptoms will be asked to leave the trial grounds and will not be allowed to return. No refund will be issued.
3. Please carefully read the CKC's recommended COVID obedience protocols document carefully. There have been some temporary rule changes that will most likely affect you! <https://www.ckc.ca/en/Files/Forms/Shows-Trials/Event-Rules-Regulations/COVID19-Obedience-and-Rally-Rules-General-Guidelin>
4. It is required, all exhibitors wear a mask except when running a dog in a class.
5. The gate board will be available near the rings for exhibitors to indicate they are present and running in the class. DO NOT TOUCH THE BOARD. A steward will mark you as present and make any run order changes that are needed. A 6 Feet / 2 Metre buffer will be marked around the gate steward.
6. Exhibitors will remove and retrieve their own leashes. A chair or other object will be placed in the ring for the leash.
7. MAINTAIN 6 Feet / 2 Metre SPACING at all times.
8. Equipment will be sanitized at the end of each day and if/when stewards are changed.

Assumption of the Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/ COVID-19

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, Federal, Provincial and Local governments and Federal / Provincial health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, imposed restrictions on the congregation of groups of people.

The Belgian Shepherd dog club of Canada and Parkland Kennels West Inc, have put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however BSDCC/Parkland Kennels cannot guarantee that you will not become infected with COVID-19. On my behalf, I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless BSDCC or Parkland Kennels, its members, agents, representatives and volunteers, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. I understand and agree that this release includes my Claims based on the actions, omissions or negligence of BSDCC or Parkland Kennels members, agents, representatives and volunteers, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during or after participation in any BSDCC Obedience event at Parkland Kennels West Inc.
